

Die Mobilitäts-Teilnehmer wurden in einem eintägigen Workshop auf die Lernziele der Reise und die Lernsituation in Ravenna vorbereitet. Auf einer digitalen Plattform wurden alle Reise-Unterlagen, ein Reise-Blog

und eine Foto-Galerie zur Vergügung gestellt. Diese wurden dann während der Lernmobilität ausgiebig genutzt. In Ravenna hatten wir hochkarätige Spezialisten verpflichtet, die uns die Lern-Themen näher gebracht haben: -Ein Professor für Restaurations-Architektur der Universität Bologna hat uns die Besonderheiten der Architektur der aus dem 5. und 6. Jahrhundert stammenden Welterbe-Stätten erläutert, gebäudetechnische Zensur bei Regimewechsel inklusive. - Ein Biologe hat uns die Einflüsse von Natur und Mensch auf die Veränderungen des Po-Deltas und mit ihm der Wirtschafts- und Siedlungssituation in der Region während der letzten 1000 Jahre erklärt. Ein bekannter Regisseur war bei unserer Gruppe zu Gast und hat uns mit dem Film "Il deserto rosso" die Entwicklung Ravennas von einem dreckigen, schwarzen Idustriestandort der 1960er Jahre hin zu einer ökologisch ausgerichteten heutigen Gesellschaft gezeigt. Bei diesen Entwicklungen spielt die EU seit ihrem Bestehen eine zentrale Rolle. - Ein renomierter Dichter und Librettist hat aus seinen Werken gelesen und die Feinheiten der italienischen Sprache und des rmangolischen Dialekts illustriert. Eine Ärztin und Köchin hat die Spezialitäten und Besonderheiten der romangolischen Küche praktisch erklärt. - Wir waren in einer traditionellen Mosaikwerkstatt und haben die Tätigkeiten und die Arbeitssituation der Mosaicisti kennengelernt. Bei einem Atelierbesuch bei einer Mosaicista und Bildhauerin haben wir gelernt, wie Naturbeobachtung und philosophie die künstlerische Arbeit beeinflussen kann. Außerdem war zu beobachten, wie sich eine Frau erfolgreich in der vorwiegend männlich ausgerichteten handwerklichen Arbeitswelt behaupten kann.
